



ADRISTORICAL LANDS

Dođite u Hercegovinu, gdje se susreću mnoge kulture i stvaraju jednu od najbogatijih kulturnih baština južne Evrope. Hercegovina je čarobno putovanje kroz zemlju koja je nekoć ugostila rimske istraživače i turske osvajače. Pozivamo Vas da dođete otkriti drevnu zemlju koja spaja istok i zapad.

Bilo da ste u opuštenoj šetnji kroz **Stari grad** u Mostaru ili se divite fascinirajućim znamenitostima i zvucima rijeke Neretve koja protiče ispod **Starog mosta (1)**, vidjet ćete zašto je Mostar srce hercegovačke bogate kulturne baštine. U Mostaru, doživjet ćete šetnju kroz njenu drevnu prošlost, otkrivajući desetine zanata i radionica poredanih po Starom gradu. Osmanska arhitektura veličanstveno je ilustrirana u stoljetnoj **Koski Mehmed-pašinoj džamiji (7)**. Južno od Mostara je **Blagaj (11)**, bivše sjedište herceg Stjepana, koji je vladao Hercegovinom sa svoje tvrđave smještene na vrhu iznad **izvora rijeke Bune**. Sultan je smatrao da je ovo mjesto tako čarobno da je naredio da se izgradi **Tekija (12)** - derviški samostan u 16. stoljeću na samom izvoru. To je idealno mjesto za opuštajuću tursku kafu i orijentalne slatkiše.

Samo kratka vožnja, dijeli vas od poznatog grada **Počitelja (5)** naslonjenog na padinu, neobičnog i šarmantnog podsjetnika na prošlost Hercegovine. Nešto južnije, na **Radimlji (9)**, je najveća nekropola u BiH, i drevni ilirski grad **Daorson** na Ošanićima kod **Stoca**. U blizini se nalazi **Međugorje (2)**, drugo najveće katoličko mjesto hodočašća na svijetu. Ovdje je, 1981. godine, nekoliko mladih župljana imalo viziju Djevice Marije, a od tada Međugorje privlači milijune hodočasnika i posjetitelja.

Ne želite propustiti staro rimsko naselje, **Mogorjelo (6)** koje se nalazi blizu grada **Čapljine**. Zatim, razmislite o opuštanju i odmaranju u gradu na obali Jadranskog mora, **Neumu (8)**.

Ne propustite još **Konjic (10)**, grad koji je dom tradicionalnog drvorezbarstva koje se prenosi s oca na sina kroz mnoge generacije.

Dalje prema sjeveru, nedaleko od **Prozor-Rame**, nalazi se **Franjevački samostan Šćit (4)**.

Sigurni smo da će vas Hercegovina očarati i inspirirati. Dođite otkriti čari Hercegovine.

Come to Herzegovina, where many cultures meet and create one of the richest cultural heritages of southern Europe. Herzegovina is a magical journey through lands that once hosted Roman explorers and Ottoman invaders. We invite you to come discover the ancient lands that unite East and West.

Whether you're taking a leisurely stroll through **Mostar's historical old town** or admiring the fascinating sights and sounds of the Neretva River that surges under the **Old Bridge (1)**, you'll see why Mostar is the heart of Herzegovina's rich cultural heritage. In Mostar you'll experience a walk through her ancient past, discovering the dozens of handicraft and artisan shops that line the old town. Ottoman architecture is magnificently exemplified in the centuries old **Koski Mehmed-pasha Mosque (7)**. Just south of Mostar is **Blagaj (11)**, the former seat of Duke Stjepan, who ruled Herzegovina from his fortress perched on a peak above the **Buna River Spring**. The Sultan found this place so magical that he ordered a **Dervish Monastery (12)** built in the 16th century right at the source. It's an ideal place for a relaxing Turkish coffee and an oriental sweet.

Only a short ride away, tucked into a hillside is the famous town of **Počitelj (5)**, a quaint and charming reminder of Herzegovina's past. To the south is the largest necropolis in B&H at **Radimlja (9)**, and the ancient Illyrian town Daorson at Ošanići near **Stolac**. Nearby is **Međugorje (2)**, the second largest Catholic pilgrimage site in the world. Here, in the 1981, several young parishioners received a vision of the Virgin Mary and since then Međugorje has attracted millions of pilgrims and visitors.

You won't want to miss the ancient Roman settlement of **Mogorjelo (6)** located near the town of **Čapljina**. Then, consider relaxing and unwinding in the Adriatic coastal town of **Neum (8)**.

Another don't miss: Town of **Konjic (10)** is home to traditional woodwork shops that have been passed down from father to son over many generations.

Further to the north, located near **Prozor-Rama**, there is a **Franciscan Monastery Šćit (4)**.

We're sure Herzegovina will fascinate and inspire you. Come discover the magic of Herzegovina.

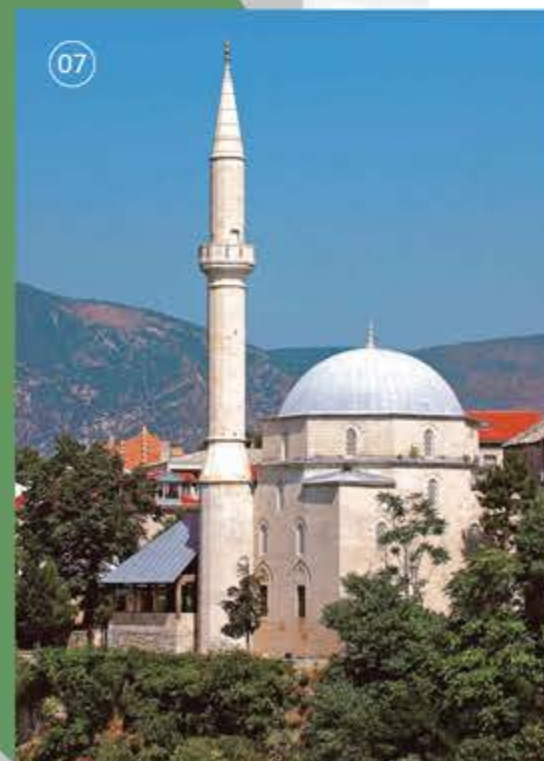
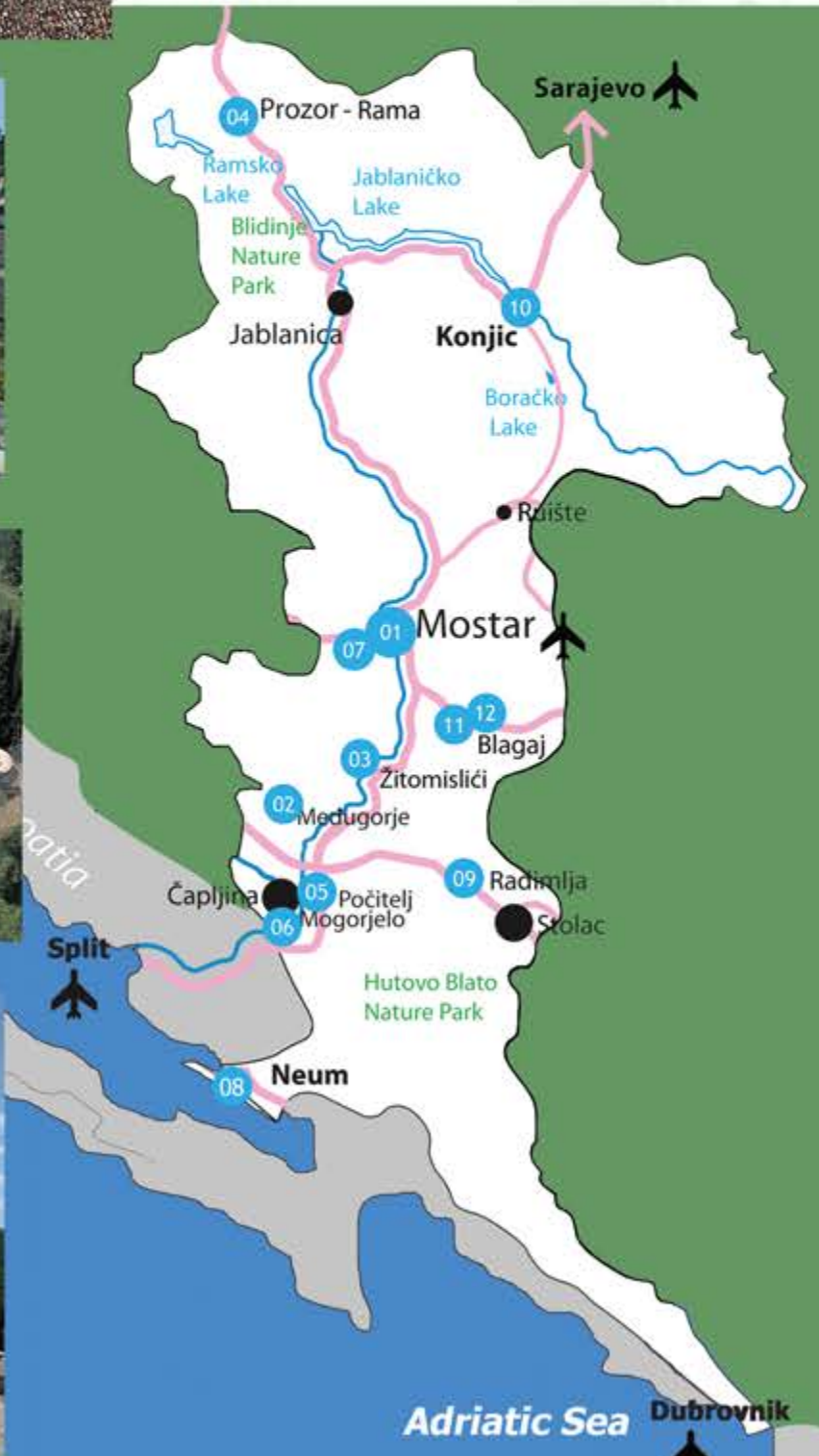
